Advisory Committee on Curriculum and Textbooks Reform

Terms of Reference

Education had been on concurrent list of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973. Thus, curriculum and textbooks development/ review/improvement were a joint responsibility of both federal and provincial governments. However, after the 18th Constitutional Amendment education has been devolved to provinces and, curriculum and textbooks development has become sole responsibility of provinces which will require capacity building of Bureau of Curriculum and Extension Wing Sindh and Sindh Textbook Board, Jamshoro. In order to streamline process of developing curriculum policy, curriculum planning, implementation and review/evaluation, an advisory committee has been formed to advise the Secretary (Education & Literacy) in curriculum and textbooks policy, planning, development, implementation and review/evaluation matters. Overall, the committee will serve as 'Think-Thank' to the Department of Education and Literacy, Government of Sindh.

Terms of Reference (ToRs)

1. Assist in preparing curriculum policy and curriculum framework including learning competencies, content standards, performance standards, benchmarks, and student learning outcomes;
2. Guide in development of curriculum, textbooks, teacher guide, and instructional material matters;
3. Advise in review/evaluation of curriculum, textbooks, teacher guide, and instructional material;
4. Share innovative ideas for improving curriculum, textbooks, teacher guide, and instructional material;
5. Guide in developing curriculum implementation framework;
6. Assist in developing curriculum monitoring and evaluation framework with key outcome indicators;



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7. Guide in curriculum / textbooks research to continue improving curriculum and textbooks;
8. Advocate participation of teachers in curriculum and textbooks development;
9. Assist in developing framework for reviewing national curriculum 2006 by identifying gaps for further improvement as progressive and practical curriculum; and
10. Assist in developing framework for reviewing the existing textbooks/teacher guides, instructional material for revising and developing new textbooks based on national curriculum 2006.

Meeting of the committee would be held on monthly basis and would be held on last Saturday of every month.

Tenure of Membership

Members based on their expertise in curriculum, textbooks and instructional material development will be selected for a period of two years which is extendable for further two years.
